- Vote for your favorite art.
- Winners will be announced *October 15th*. (Four winners in each category: 0-5 years old, 6-12 years old, 13-17 years old, and 18 and older. The prize is a \$25 gift card each.)
- Art may be picked up on *October 18th*. (You will receive an easel with your art.)
